CORVETTE TOUR BRINGS THOUSANDS TO FLAGSTAFF

2ND ANNUAL CORVETTE'N AMERICA ROAD TOURS SET FOR JUNE 8-10

Hundreds of America's favorite sports car are expected to converge on Flagstaff in brilliant streaks of Millennium Yellow, Ontario Orange and Victory Red as the 2nd Annual Corvette'N America Road Tours revs up this Rt. 66 mountain town June 8 - 10. Corvette enthusiasts from all over the country, including General Motors legends of Corvette design and engineering, are scheduled to roll in to Little America Hotel on Thursday, June 8.

Participating throughout the tour will be General Motors VIPs and icons of the Corvette world, Arv Mueller and Jerry Palmer. Now retired, these top GM executives are credited with the impressive look and power behind the Corvette during

their 40+ years with the automaker.

The highlight of the event is the Sedona Road Tour in which a caravan of Corvettes will wind down Highway 89A from the cool pines of northern Arizona through scenic Oak Creek Canyon and on to the towering spires and time-carved monuments of the red rock country.

Road tour participants will stage in Flagstaff on Friday, June 9, and will launch for Sedona at 8:30 a.m. with a police escort through town. This parade of Corvettes will finish up the day trip in Flagstaff ending with a tour down America's highway, Rt. 66 and arriving at the historic Museum Club, a Route 66 roadhouse at 4:30 p.m.

Also included is a dazzling Show

& Shine event on the grassy ball fields at Flagstaff High School from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., Saturday, June 10. Set against a spectacular backdrop of the majestic San Francisco Peaks, this sea of Corvettes will be on display to the public for an admission fee of \$5 (children ages 12 and under get in free).

"For car lovers, this is a serious immersion of glitz and glitter. Vette owners and experts will be available to talk about this distinctive sports car that has long symbolized the American spirit and adventure of the open road," said event developer and coordinator Dwayne Publitz.

Twenty percent of the Show & Shine proceeds will benefit the Flagstaff Unified School District. Also on tap are a Welcome

Reception and Awards Banquet with a presentation by the two GM Guests of Honor.

"Last year marked Flagstaff's inaugural event with more than 200 participants from 13 states. Now that the word is out on our cool summer temperatures and stunning mountain views, we expect as many as 800 Vette owners will want to experience some of Arizona's most spectacular scenery from the front seat of their favorite vehicle," said event developer and coordinator Cindy Publitz. "We anticipate a significant economic impact on the area."
